Information pertinent to your particular trip concerning transportation, lodging and personal items needed will be dealt with at the time a trip is booked.

We would appreciate your making us aware of any physical disabilities you may have that require special attention.

Any questions you may have will be cheerfully answered — please ask.

All fishing trips are designed for two guests, with your guide, to each aluminum drift boat. All bait & tackle is provided at no extra charge, however you are welcome to bring your own. An Oregon fishing license & Salmon-Steelhead tag are needed for the number of days you plan to fish.

On all trips we encourage you to bring along a sweat-shirt or light jacket, hat, sunglasses & rain gear.

## RESERVATIONS & DEPOSITS

Early reservations are recommended to assure the date(s) of your choice. If you desire, assistance will be given to arrange your lodging in local motels.

A 50% deposit is required to confirm all trips. Although cancellation of a trip is unlikely, we reserve the right to cancel a trip due to severe weather or high-water conditions. In these cases your deposit would be refundable or your trip rescheduled.

Your guides are fully insured for your protection, and registered with the Oregon Marine Board. Careful preparations are made to ensure you and your party a safe, enjoyable trip to be remembered.

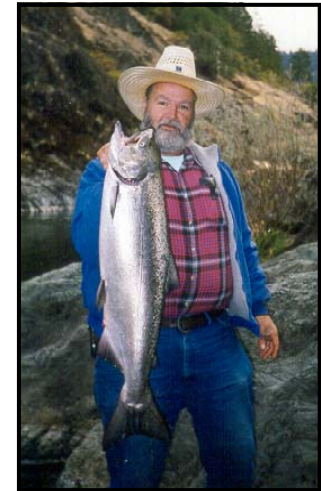

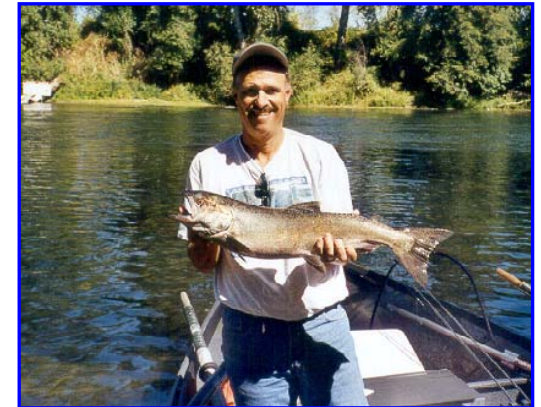
